



## STATEMENT ON EWQ ZONE OY'S CARBON FOOTPRINT CALCULATION

At the request of EWQ Zone Oy, Green Carbon Finland Oy has performed an assessment of their corporate carbon footprint calculation for the calendar year 2025. EWQ Zone Oy provided the calculation and all necessary background information.

The calculation included the following emission categories:

### Scope 1 – Mobile combustion

- Use of fuels.

### Scope 2 – Purchased energy

- Use of electricity and district heating. The electricity used was certified nuclear.

### Scope 3 – Purchased goods and services

- Production of purchased goods.

### Scope 3 – Capital goods

- Production of capital goods.

### Scope 3 – Fuel- and energy-related activities

- Fuel production; production and transmission loss of district heating.

### Scope 3 – Upstream transportation and distribution

- Upstream transport accounted for using the WTW boundary.

### Scope 3 - Waste

- Treatment of waste generated from the companies own operations.

### Scope 3 – Business travel

- Business travel undertaken by employees.

### Scope 3 – Employee commuting

- Employee commuting between their home and workplace.

### Scope 3 – Downstream transportation and distribution

- Downstream transport accounted for using the WTW boundary.

### Scope 3 – Use of sold products

- Accounted for together with end-of-life treatment of sold products.

### Scope 3 – End-of-life treatment of sold products

- Accounted for together with use of sold products.

### Scope 3 – Investments

- Unaccounted for due to the bank not providing the necessary data.

Green Carbon states that EWQ Zone Oy's corporate carbon footprint calculation complies with both the GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (2004) and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard (2011). The calculation boundary is appropriate in relation to the company's operations and includes the emission sources covered by the defined boundary. The emission factors used are justified and derived from reliable sources.
